Club Visitations

Are you ready to learn new ideas? How about getting few other lions with you and go visit other clubs during there club meetings or events. All you have to do is fill out the form and submit to Sue Szucs and report in MyLCI

2023-2024 Visitation Form

Inter-Club Visitation Contest

Visitation awards are given to clubs and individual members who visit all the clubs in a Region (Short Tail Award) or throughout the District (Long Tail Award). The chairperson evaluates the contest winner using these criteria:

- Individual member visits and club visits must be recorded in MyLion. Each entry must include the names of club members participating in the visit, the club being visited, and the meeting or club event date.
- You should notify the chairperson when you believe the criteria are met and provide substantiating information. The chairperson validates the records using MyLion.
- Visitations by the same club or individual on the same day to two clubs with overlapping meeting times do not count towards a visitation.
- The contests run from April 1, 2021, to March 31, 2022.

Note: Please allow adequate time for the chairperson to validate your visitation. If you wait until the end of the contest or do not provide sufficient information to locate the entry in MyLion, the chairperson might not be able to count all of your points.

Visitations by Clubs

The visiting party of members from your club must meet the minimum requirement for your Category:

- Category 1: 2 members

- Category 2: 3 members
- Category 3: 4 members (see General Rules for All Contests)

Point System

One point per required member and **three points** for each additional member is awarded over the minimum for each one-way mile. For example, a Category 2 club visiting a club 20 miles away is awarded 60 points for a one-way drive. If the club sent two additional members, that would add 120 points for the one-way drive. Thus, the club receives a total of 180 points. Do not calculate round-trip points.

There is a minimum of **100 points** per visitation. Zoom meetings are **100 points**. You will receive **50 bonus points** when you visit clubs in your Zone and **75 bonus points** for visiting clubs in your Region. When you visit clubs outside of your Region but still within District 4-C6, you receive **100 bonus** points.

Clubs can also receive visitation points for sending members to District-sponsored social or fundraising events (excluding regular fundraising events such as bingo). Examples of these events are Cabinet, Zone, or in-person training. Your club receives **100 points** for each member attending the event.

For events where members travel outside of the District, such as a convention, you can receive a maximum of **200 points** per member.

Individual Visitations

You will receive **one point** for attending another club's meeting or event, a District meeting or event, and conventions.

Exceptions

- Other than for Cabinet meetings, District Cabinet officers, Global Action Team members, or Committee members do not receive visitation points when the visit serves to fulfill the duties of their office.
- First and Second Vice District Governor candidates may only achieve visitation points when visiting as part of their club.
- Associate members and guests do not count for visitations points.
- Funerals and weddings do not count for visitation points.
